Police Report

On 10/10/2016 at about 2:28 p.m., the LeRoy Police received a call of a person with a rifle on the property of the LeRoy Sewage Treatment Plant located on Red Mill Rd in LeRoy. This call resulted in a subsequent search of the area by numerous police agencies and criminal charges being placed against the suspect 26 yr old Zachary R. Reed of 6949 Britt Rd in LeRoy. Reed was charged with one count of Obstructing Governmental Administration, a Class A-Misdemeanor. It is alleged that Reed obstructed or prevented a police officer from performing his official function when he failed to follow the direct orders of the initial responding LeRoy Police Officer who confronted Reed ordering him out of the woods with his hands up. Reed ignored this order and instead returned to the woods with the gun and attempted to leave the area. After police set up a perimeter, Reed was identified and contacted on his cell phone at which time Reed agreed to come out of the woods. Reed met the patrols across the creek in a cemetery on North St where he was taken into custody, but he did so without the gun. A subsequent search of a nearby weeded area resulted in the recovery of the gun. It was learned from Reed that he was hunting squirrels in

the area with a .22 rifle. The LeRoy Police Department were assisted by patrols from the New York State Police and the Genesee County Sheriff's Office. Reed was released on an appearance ticket to appear in LeRoy Town Court on a later date.

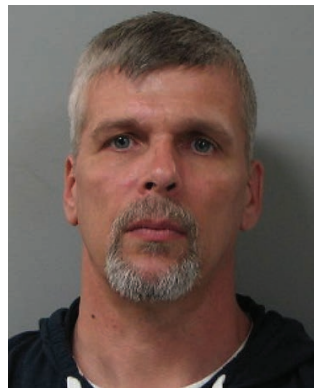
10/08/2016

33 yr old Matthew R. McQuillen of 38 Lathrop Avenue in LeRoy was arrested on 10/10/2016 by the LeRoy Police Department and charged with one count of Petit Larceny, a class A-Misdemeanor. It is alleged that on 10/08/2016 at about 4:00 pm, McQuillen stole a DVD from a store located on West Avenue in LeRoy. McQuillen was released on an Appearance ticket to appear in LeRoy Town Court on a later date.

10/04/2016

A five month investigation into three residential burglaries in the West Main Street area of the Village of LeRoy concluded on 10/04/2016 with the arrest of Thomas A. Park age 48 by the LeRoy Police Department. Park is from the LeRoy/Pavilion area but is currently living in the City of Rochester. It is alleged that during the months of April, May and June of 2016, Park unlawfully entered three different residences in LeRoy and stole items from each consisting of cash jewelry and a

crossbow. It is further alleged that Park then pawned some of the property in Batavia. Park was charged with three counts of Burglary in the Second Degree, a class C-Felony and three counts of Petit Larceny, a class A-Misdemeanor. Park was arraigned before the LeRoy Town Court and released RUS as he is being overseen by Genesee Justice and the Rochester City Drug Court. See photo attached.

LeRoy Junior Knights

LeRoy 30 – GVB 14

Game 6 of the Junior Knights' season was hosted at Hartwood Park. The Genesee Valley Bills brought their 5-0 record and a defense that had not allowed a point in 5 games to town. This game between two undefeated teams would be for first place in the division and a potential spot in the CYFL Championship Game.

GVB won the toss and chose to defer allowing the Knights to start the game with possession of the ball. LeRoy was able to draw the defense off sides on the first play of game giving them 1st & 5 at GVB's 40 yard line. A run for 6 yards by Adam Woodworth sandwiched by runs of 2 yards and 4 yards by Luke Lathan, gave LeRoy 1st & 10 from GVB's 48 yard. Crushing blocks by Jake Higgins, Jude Sherman and Luke Lathan paved the way for Adam Woodworth to sprint 28 yards for the touchdown, as the Knights made an early statement to the GVB defense. Luke Lathan pounded it in for the PAT making the early score LeRoy 8 – GVB – 0.

GVB's first possession began with a 20 yard run around the right side, followed by a 3 yard carry setting up 2nd & 3 from LeRoy's 47. However, a high snap got away from the GVB quarterback and Aaric Luce out hustled the GVB backs to recover the fumble.

The turnover gave LeRoy the ball at GVB's 48 yard line and a chance to extend an early lead. The Junior Knights start-

ed their drive with runs of 4 and 5 yards by Luke Lathan, 3 yards by Adam Woodworth and 3 yards by Jude Sherman giving LeRoy a 2nd & 7 at GVB's 34 yard line. Again, LeRoy's offensive line with the help of lead blockers Jude Sherman and Luke Lathan, allowed Adam Woodworth to get to the edge and race 34 yards for the touchdown. Woodworth followed it with a run for the extra point. LeRoy 16 – GVB – 0.

The GVB Bills, on their next possession, made it known they were not going to go away that easy. The Bills offense struck back with a 10 play drive of their own, closing to within 8. LeRoy 16 – GVB 8.

The Junior Knights would answer GVB's drive with one of their own. However, unlike their typical up tempo scoring drives, the Knights pounded the ball down the field over the course of 16 plays featuring power runs by Woodworth, Lathan & Sherman behind the line of Jake Higgins, Jace Jedrewski, Aaric Luce, Holden Sullivan, DJ O'Geen, Wyatt Draper and Grady Gilligan. The drive ended with a score on 4th and Goal from the 6 yard line when Adam Woodworth, behind crushing lead blocks by Lathan and Sherman, scored off the right side. PAT failed. LeRoy 22 – GVB – 8.

GVB had one more chance with the ball before the end of the half. Right away it looked like they may take advantage of it. Runs of 12 yards and 32

yards set the Bills up at LeRoy's 15 yard line. 3 more runs by GVB set up 4th & 2 from LeRoy's 7 yard line and a chance for GVB to close the gap. However, Jack Egeling and Luke Lathan exploded through the line to bury the running back in the backfield and preserve the 22 -8 halftime lead.

GVB started the second half with the football and immediately set out to make a second half statement. On the first play, the Bills burst down field for 40 yards down to the LeRoy 25. However, LeRoy's defense stiffened while pushing the Bills backwards and forcing them to turn the ball over on downs on an incomplete pass on 4th and long.

GVB's defense answered and held the Junior Knights forcing them to turn the ball over on downs at their own 36 yard line. Eight plays later, GVB scored on an 8 yard run. The Junior Knights stopped GVB on the PAT however; GVB had made it a one score game. LeRoy 22 – GVB 14.

Each team would be forced to punt on their next two possessions.

This would set up the LeRoy's most important drive of the game. Taking over at their own 25 yard line and not wanting to give the ball back to the Bills, the Junior Knights attacked the middle of the GVB defense. 5 straight runs "up the gut" between the blocks of DJ O'Geen and Wyatt Draper, including a 20 yard burst by

Luke Lathan, moved the ball to GVB's 33 yard line. The 6th straight time proved to be the difference as Draper and O'Geen opened a gaping hole on the left side and Lathan and Sherman made easy work of the linebackers allowing Woodworth to sprint 33 yards for the touchdown. A successful PAT by Woodworth pushed the score to LeRoy 30 – Avon 14.

The game would end with score of LeRoy 30 – GVB 14 as LeRoy turned the Bills over on downs on their final possession. This allowed the Junior Knights to assume the "Victory Position" and kneel on the ball for the final two plays.

Adam Woodworth led all ball carriers with 20 touches for 188 yards and 4 touchdowns. Luke Lathan had 12 carries for a hard fought 55 yards and Jude Sherman gained 20 yards on 5 carries.

Jude Sherman led the LeRoy defense with 11 tackles. Aaric Luce and Luke Lathan followed with 7 tackles each. Jake Higgins had 6 tackles, Jack Egeling and Adam Woodworth each had 4. With 2 tackles each were Jacob Bowman, Joey Reschke, Holden Sullivan and Dawson "WoJo" Wojtaszczyk. Chipping in with 1 tackle each were Alex Spezzano, Noah Kaczanowski, Wyatt Draper, Connor Elmore and CC Corcimiglia.

LeRoy plays at Dansville this Sunday, October 16th at noon.

LeRoy Pee Wee Football

LeRoy 6 - GVB 0

The LeRoy Knights Pee Wee squad (comprised of 1st and 2nd graders) engaged in a hard hitting defensive battle with the Genesee Valley Bills on Sunday October 9th. The game was held at a dew covered Hartwood Park and featured the stars of the Knights future. LeRoy would combine excellent defensive play with timely offensive output to come out on top 6-0.

GVB started with the ball on their own 35 yard line. GVB moved the ball initially, but the defensive line of Jeremiah Sheehan, Mikey Fortuna, Tommy "Dozer" McGinnis and Jordon Green made some big stops, forcing a turnover on downs.

LeRoy's offense took the ball over and started moving the ball right away. The complex offense used multiple formations to keep the Bills defense on their heels. With a couple first down runs by Issac Stella and Brady McClurg, the Knights moved the sticks. However the tough GVB defense made some key stops and the ball went back to GVB.

GVB's next series started with some outside runs, but LeRoy outside linebackers and cornerbacks Zach Coates, Eli Pattridge, Deacon Queal, Ryan O'Geen, Grant Northrup, and Mia Strollo all made key stops, containing the outside. This time GVB would once again turn the ball over on a fumble recovery by an opportunistic ball-seeking missile, also known as Brady McClurg.


Again, the LeRoy offense kept the Bills defense guessing,

as multiple looks from quarterbacks Brady McClurg, Isaac Stella, and speedy Mia Strollo created confusion on the defensive side of the ball. With key blocking from Simon Greene and David Wojtaszczyk, Isaac Stella made some long quarterback keeper runs to the outside. Brady McClurg would also add another huge run, but once again LeRoy's offense stalled and could not score.

LeRoy would start with the ball in the third quarter. Isaac Stella would march the Knights all the way down the GVB 23 yard line with some hard running. Then, with key blocks from David Wojtaszczyk and Jeremiah Sheehan, Brady McClurg scooted through the left side of the line, juking and jiving his way all the way to a 23 yard TD! Strong defensive efforts throughout the rest of the 3rd quarter would keep the score 6-0 LeRoy heading into the 4th quarter.

The start of the fourth quarter had GVB down 6 points and desperately needing a score. But the LeRoy Knights defense had other ideas. Led by thundering hits from the "silent assassin" Jeremiah Sheehan, the Bills could not move the ball on the Knights. The Knights defense was too much, causing another a quick turnover on downs. 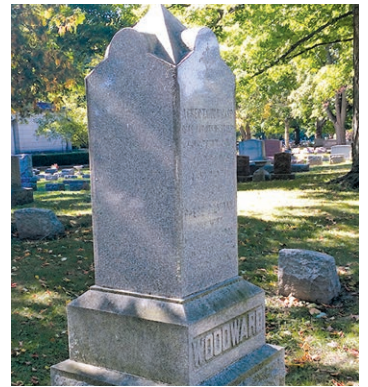

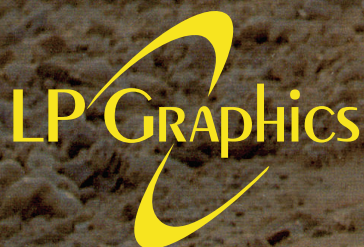

LeRoy Senior Football

LeRoy 8 - GVB 12

In a matchup of CYFL Northern Division heavyweights, the Genesee Valley Bills handed the LeRoy Senior squad their first loss of the season in a closely contested battle at Hartwood Park. The physical contest featured excellent defense by both squads as this rivalry heated up once again in front of a packed house.

GVB elected to kick off to begin the game, and attempted an onside kick. A heady Adrian Stephens recovered the kick, giving the Knights the ball at the GVB 48. Drew Strollo started out the drive with an 11 yard run, followed by gains by Tony Piazza and Jackson Fix. A tackle for loss by GVB and offsides penalty by LeRoy brought a third and long for the Knights offense. But Tommy Condidorio would hit Ryan Higgins for a 22 yard gain, giving the Knights a first down at the GVB 10 yard line. Three plays later, Strollo would elude defenders on his way to the house for a 4 yard TD. A failed conversion attempt left the score at 6-0 LeRoy.

GVB did not take long at all to respond. Only 3 plays later, the game was tied up after a couple long runs. Antonio Martinez made a key stop on the conversion attempt, leaving the score tied at 6 early in the game.

A 35 yard kickoff return by Drew Strollo put the Knights offense in excellent starting field position for their 2nd offensive drive. Hard running by Strollo and Jackson Fix behind fullback Tony Piazza would bring the ball inside the Bills 5 yard line. However on 4th and short, GVB's defense would provide resistance on a very close play, forcing a turnover on downs without a measurement.

The Bills offense then began a very long drive on their own 5 yard line. Using a balance of running and passing, the of-

fense was soon in scoring position. A long pass appeared to be leading to another Bills TD, however a hustling Drew Strollo tracked the receiver down and tackled him at the 1 yard line. On the next play, inside linebacker Tony Piazza hammered the runner at the 1 preventing a TD. A blatant block in the back nullified a GVB score on the next play, pushing the Bills back 15 yards. LeRoy would complete the epic defensive stand when Antonio Martinez made a one handed interception at the 11 yard line.

LeRoy was forced to punt quickly from inside the 10, however a big boot from Bryce Lathan gave the defense some breathing room. Good pass defense stopped GVB to end the half with the score 6-6.

The Bills offense came out in the 2nd half firing on all cylinders, also drawing the Knights defense offsides on multiple occasions. Eventually the Bills scored on their 10th play of the drive. Xavien Walker, Bryce Lathan, and Connor McGee would converge on the runner to stop the conversion attempt, giving the Bills a 12-6 lead.

Another failed onside kick attempt gave the Knights the ball on the 50. A pass to Drew Strollo, and nice gains from Jackson Fix and Riley Williams had the Knights offense moving down the field swiftly inside the 25. However an unflagged late helmet to helmet hit knocked QB Tommy Condidorio out of the game. The Knights offense continued to move however, but only 5 plays later another unflagged helmet to helmet hit would knock Strollo out of the game. On fourth down and 1 at the GVB 5 yard line, GVB's defense stood tall again, as another close play resulted in a turnover on downs without a measurement.

LeRoy's defense came out fired up to start the

4th quarter with GVB starting their drive on their own 5 yard line. Four plays later, penetration from Ryan Higgins and Bryce Lathan resulted in a safety, inching the Knights closer with a 12-8 score.

An excellent free kick by GVB put the Knights offense on their own 45 yard line. The Bills defense dominated the Knights offense, quickly forcing a turnover on downs. LeRoy's defense was up to the task as well, eventually forcing a turnover on downs to give the Knights offense one final chance. The Knights squad however was unable to muster up any offensive firepower, turning the ball over after 4 plays to end the game.

Tony Piazza led the Knights defense with 6 tackles. The defensive effort kept the Knights in the game, emphasizing team cohesion and hustle. Riley Williams (4), Xavien

Walker (5), Antonio Martinez (4), Jackson Fix (4), Drew Strollo (4), Connor McGee (3) and Bryce Lathan (4) all made multiple tackles as well. Martinez had a highlight reel interception and Lathan had a safety. Also contributing with tackles were William Bogan, Jack Lathan, Connor Hege- man (2), Ayden Riggi, Ryan Higgins, and Hunter Beverly.

Drew Strollo led the offense with 50 yards on the ground and 7 yards receiving, including a rushing TD. Jackson Fix added 43 yards on the ground while Ryan Higgins had a huge 22 yard reception. 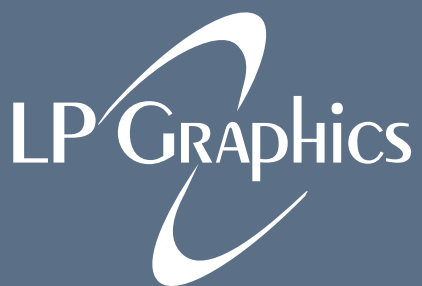
